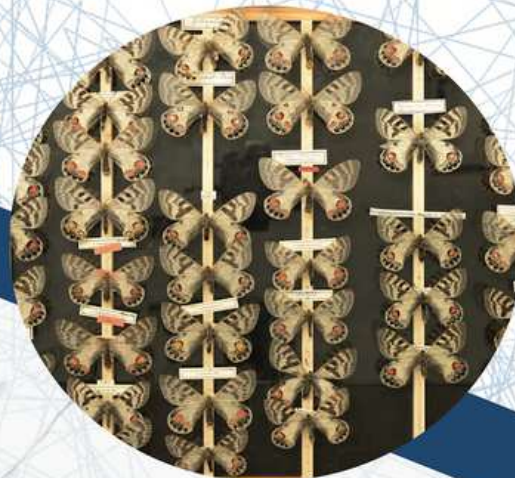


WHO WE ARE

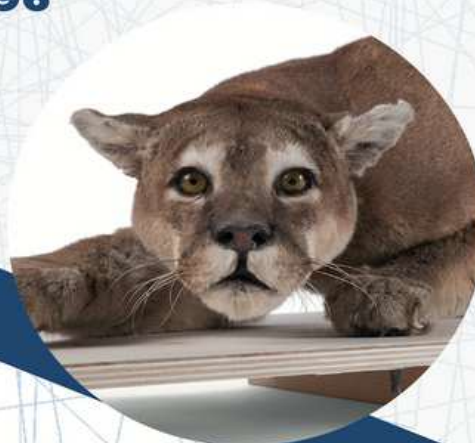


CETAF is Europe's network of biological and geological collections.
